



GPAMA, 8 November 2017, Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 1815. Quorum established. Treasurer's Report showed \$179.14 in checking, etc.

1. Oil and Gas Ordinance in Sandoval County. Next hearing at full commission on Thursday, November 16, 6:00 p. m. at the County Court House, 3rd Floor, Dahlia Road. Still working with CommonGroundRising.org. Corrales Comment will publish something tomorrow.
2. Rio Grande Trail. SV reached out to Taos County Greens who want Enchanted Circle trail included.
3. Belén Marsh Clean-up. Went well, three GPAMA members participated. We should expect photo and write-up in the Audobon newsletter for Central New Mexico.
4. Solar Fiesta and Informal Gathering. Two solar ovens were set up. We collected glyphosate petition signatures. Had five GPAMA members present at Solar Fiesta. Two other people joined us at the Ponderosa Brewery.
5. IDO. EW gave summary. GPAMA on board with some sort of demonstration/action on Monday. Will post the WSCONA documents on FB page. SV will contact Kathleen Burke and Andres Valdez (Vecinos Unidos) about action co-ordination.
6. Brief discussion of election results nationwide. Election strategy of exposing exclusionary tactics by major parties. SV putting out calls for candidates on Facebook.
7. Outreach. RK will contact UNM, CNM, SIPI, and APS about tabling or other opportunities. SV estimates that we need \$3,000 to do outreach. Recommends selling prayer flags. Need to clarify with SoS the applicable regulations and reporting requirements.
8. Glyphosate Petition. SV reminds us that more information is coming out regarding ill-effects. He will make IPRA request about contractors' use of glyphosate. He got the petitions from SK and will count signatures.
9. SV attending various affinity group meetings, Sierra Club (Wed. office hours), 350.org. He continues to make contacts with affinity groups.
10. GC meeting this Saturday. Suzanne Barteau formally removed as GC Rep. Roger Kulp elected GC Rep.
