He will post on the Parks & Rec FB and Keller's page and report on any response. Michal shared that Benton and Winter co-sponsored the Bee City USA resolution. Michal will contact the person at a bee group. Roger sent a question to Fagerlund. Roger will contact Tractor Brewing about the missing petitions. Em will continue Francine's work on putting petition information into a spreadsheet. We will collate information at the next meeting.

Em will send copy of Stephen's NRC letter to attendees at this meeting and assign each person a paragraph to fact-check. Sarah had some concerns about 350.org's nuclear energy endorsement and wondered if GPAMA should make a statement. She will reach out to 350.org and get more information to present to GPAMA.
