



GPAMA Minutes
8 November 2018
The Source

The meeting was called to order at 1827. Quorum was established. Minutes for October formally approved. Treasurer Mudd reported \$128.83 (checking)+\$5.00 (savings)+undeposited donations of \$15 to \$20.

Glyphosate letter and petition update was given. Ward shared the letter received from Mayor Keller and reported on the status of the resolution at Bernalillo County Commission. She also shared the phone number of the County manager for people to call and ask the reason the resolution was not on the agenda for November 13 as indicated at the previous Commission meeting. **Verchinski will write a letter to the editor to be ready for publication upon adoption of the resolution.**

Sandoval County Oil & Gas Ordinance update was given. Ward shared that the MRCOG meeting at which a resolution on protecting the aquifer was to be voted on was cancelled—or subsequently said to be postponed. After a brief discussion, **Verchinski will write a letter for GPAMA to submit into public comment calling for a moratorium.**

Jessica Holt was appointed as Green Council Representative (replacing Kulp who resigned). Car pool arrangements were made. **Lockridge was designated as Representative to give the local report.** Curtin proposed a brainstorming session for the GC meeting focusing on efforts to increase solar usage in the state. Lockridge proposed including economic diversity with this. **Consensus support for putting on GC agenda.**

There was discussion of a seasonal social gathering for the December meeting. **Holt will look into the availability of Vegan Outreach. Ward will check on room occupancy limit or capacity.**

Other business included a follow-up item regarding event@.us. Ward reported that it was a paid service, but the free listing was offered. Mudd offered her experience with Meet Up pertaining to the GP. There was no voiced support for taking the free listing. Ward reported a message to GPAMA about the 5G wireless ordinance considered by the city and noted that the ordinance was adopted three days prior. **Verchinski will send information regarding 5G and human safety.**

Announcements included time and venue of Green Council meeting on November 10. Holt announced a volunteer opportunity at Joy Junction on Thanksgiving and the evening before with those interested to contact her.
