11 June 2020

Meeting called to order at 1810. Quorum present. Minutes for May accepted as presented. Treasurer's report not available. Em recollected ~\$216 in the checking account.

Rich confirmed interest in being Treasurer and was named a GPAMA representative to the the Green Council.

Old Business:

1. Campaign updates. Stephen reported by text that he was still petitioning. There was mention of the possibility of requesting legislative relief from full signature requirements for minor party and independent candidates—Em will ask Stephen about this. Motion and second were made to endorse Lisa Savage from Maine for U. S. Senate. Passed without dissent. Em will put GPAMA endorsement on the Savage campaign's web site. Ryan reported that Hawkins is closing in on 80% of delegates needed for GPUS nomination. Em will send an e-mail to the PNC Delegate Committee to ask if delegates will receive a credential or other information prior to convention.
2. Holtec public comment. Em will send latest e-mail to Francine.
3. UNM protest anniversary. Em reported a snag with the final edit of the trailer and will send link to final version.
4. Glyphosate moratorium. No new information to report.

New Business:

1. Statement on policy brutality and racial profiling. Brief discussion as to putting out statement. It was noted that the 2020 Platform has a statement in it. No decision made.

Announcements. Reminder that GPAMA has a blog and invitation to write an article.

Meeting adjourned at 1853 then readjourned to formally elect Rich as Treasurer with Michal stepping down and adjourned again at 1857.
