Meeting called to order at 1821. Quorum present. Minutes for August accepted as corrected. Treasurer's report: \$216,29 in checking, box rent paid as donation. Paypal balance not transferred yet, estimated to be \$120. **Group voted \$60 donation to The Source.**

Old Business:

1. Holtec. **Letter adopted as amended at GPNM Special Convention. GPAMA will send text of letter to GPNM. Em and Rich will co-ordinate to get it published on web site and FB page along with comment deadline for others.**
2. UNM Protest Event. **Francine and Em will work with VFP on media advisory and press release. Ad budget left to discretion of Rich and Em but will try to limit it to \$10 to \$15. Flyer will be distributed on line and by e-mail list or listserv of other groups. Em will check with The Source is okay to have bayonet.**

New Business:

1. PRC Amendment. Strong consensus in opposition to the ballot amendment. **GPAMA will write letter to editor. Francine will research best timing for release. Discussion raised good talking points. Each can send in blurb to GPAMA e-mail for co-ordination. Will adopt finalise and adopt letter at next meeting on October 8 then quickly distribute.**

Campaign Updates:

1. Verchinski. Stephen reported activities to date, including interview. **Em will assist with web site this weekend. Voted \$50 donation to campaign.**
2. Hawkins/Walker. Stephen reported that Democrats in several states are trying to get Green Party off ballot.

Announcements:

1. On-line petition requests. Em reported having received two petition requests regarding the Doctrine of Discovery and Veterans affected by toxic burn pits. **Em and Rich will co-ordinate to get links on FB page. Em will send links by e-mail to attendees.**
2. Webinars. Two 350NM events shared, webinar on a sustainable economy without fracking on September 18 and the proposed PRC amendment moving to an appointed PRC on September 28. **Em will send info to attendees.**
