ANNUAL MEETING/CONVENTION

Meeting called to order at 1905 after potluck with quorum present (EW PG RY MM) and guest Matt Dodson. February minutes adopted after clarification of an item. Treasurer reported \$392.05 in checking and \$5 in savings; PayPal and petty cash not reported. Recent expenses were discussed.

Local officers elected were co-Chairs Em Ward and Rich Yost and Treasurer Michal Mudd. Secretary position is vacant. **Green Councillors elected were Pete Gleichman, Rich Yost, and Michal Mudd. All present were named delegates to the GPNM Annual Meeting and Convention on April 10, 2022.** No decision was made on meeting locally for a virtual call-in, as MM will continue to look for a meeting place in Santa Fe.

Matt Dodson, candidate for governor, addressed the group and pointed out his two main campaign issues are state-wide ranked-choice voting and no blue hydrogen for electrical energy production. A discussion followed covering issues and aspects of his campaign.

GPAMA will send an e-mail to ABQ city councillors urging adoption of a memorial to support the United Nations Treaty on the Prohibition on Nuclear Weapons. A discussion of various local topics occurred before adjournment at 2030.
