EW reported that the Valencia County NROZ was adopted with some protections restored and that Valencia Water Watchers considered the modified ordinance a partial victory.

GP is ballot qualified. **EW was given the okay to reach out to Enrique Cardiel** who is running for NM House of Representatives as an independent.

We discussed the publication the EIS for the proposed Holtec facility in SE NM with NRC staff recommending the permit. **MM will reach out to LASG for next step.**

EW gave update on redistricting, sharing that FDNM is starting a series of public meetings on the recent process.

RY reported on the RR golf course. Potential development was stalled by lawsuits, and the walking trails remain.

New Business

Hiroshima Day--no known local event. **EW will reach out to PSL to find out if that group is planning anything.** We would be willing to co-sponsor protest.

Women's Marches--MM reported that groups affiliated with the Democratic party are using events as fundraisers or political rallies.

Future Items--Pre-made signs, RCV, alternative party alliances, possible public lecture or movie.

Peter Phillips, moved to NM from CA where he was a Green, will test on-line registration to see if he can register as a Green. **Peter elected to fill Green Councillor vacancy upon successful registration as Green in New Mexico.**
