Meeting called to order at 1814 with quorum present (EW CA PP PG RY MM). July minutes adopted. Treasurer reported \$263,50 in checking, \$5 in savings. Green Council report given.

Old Business

1. EW meets with Enrique Cardiel on Saturday.
2. PG reported on his review of the final EIS on the proposed Holtec facility and that cultural and ecological standards appear to have been met. The big issue of the transportation corridor was not addressed in the study. State legislature may be the best bet to stop facility. He also reported on the proposed expansion of the WIPP. **EW will send the ppt presentation on WIPP from the VFP-ABQ meeting. PG will plan to reach out to other groups.**
3. Hiroshima Day. EW reported that PSL did not respond; MM reported that there was nothing on their FB page.
4. Rules & Regulations filing. Bernalillo County and Sandoval County received document without any fee. Filings for Sandoval and Torrance are expected this week.

New Business

1. Ranked-Choice Voting--We discussed this topic and reviewed known municipal efforts in the state. **MM will take lead on working with other groups, beginning with League of Women Voters and their webinar at the end of the month.**
2. Minor Party Alliances--PP presented information from Working Families Party (WFP)--it appears to be under the umbrella of the Democratic Party, and we briefly discussed the topic of fusion voting. We are open to discussion of electoral alliances with other minor parties.
